Saint Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral Scholarship Program

The Saint Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral Scholarship program is designed to assist students to achieve their academic, professional, and community leadership goals. It also intends to help build a commitment to the growth and preservation of our Cathedral, and our Ukrainian Orthodox heritage.

For the 2017-2018 academic year, the Saint Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral Scholarship program may award up to five (5) scholarships, to students who are currently enrolled in, or have been accepted into, an accredited post-secondary educational institution.

There are **three levels** of scholarship to be awarded:

- i) Students at the **pre-university level** (e.g. CEGEP/technical/vocational etc.) are eligible for a \$300 award.
- ii) Students at the **undergraduate university level** are eligible for a \$500 award.
- iii) Students at the **graduate and post-graduate level** (Master, PhD, Post-doc etc.) are eligible for a \$500 award.

Candidates may be awarded only once at each level.

Eligible applicants must be members in good standing of the Cathedral, or have a parent or grandparent who is a member in good standing*. Applicants must have their primary residence in Montreal, but may study abroad. Applicants must demonstrate participation and a visible and valuable contribution to the Cathedral in their application.

*a member in good standing is one whose annual dues have been paid in full for the preceding two years.

To be eligible, applicants must submit

- A) A completed application form
- B) An unofficial transcript for the most recent previous two years of study
- C) A copy of their resume
- D) A digital head and shoulders photograph

Applications may be submitted in either English or French.

Scholarship winner(s) will be awarded at the Saint Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral Patronal Feast Day luncheon on Sunday, September 24, 2017. Winners must attend the luncheon to receive and accept their scholarship. Failure to appear in person will rescind the scholarship.

Applications missing the required information or not received by the deadline shall be rejected. Selection of winners is at the discretion of the selection committee and all decisions are final. In the event that, in the opinion of the selection committee, there is no suitable candidate(s) for a scholarship(s), the selection committee and the Parish Executive of Saint Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral reserve the right to not award a scholarship(s).
